Curling

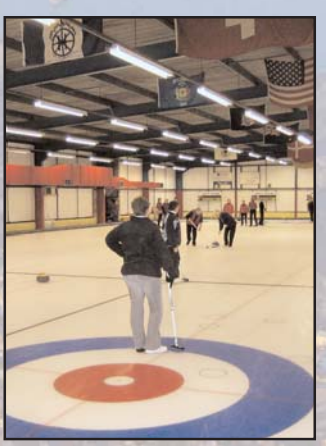


Kinross is home to the oldest Curling Club in Scotland, originating in 1668. It is even thought the game might have been devised by monks playing on Loch Leven.
